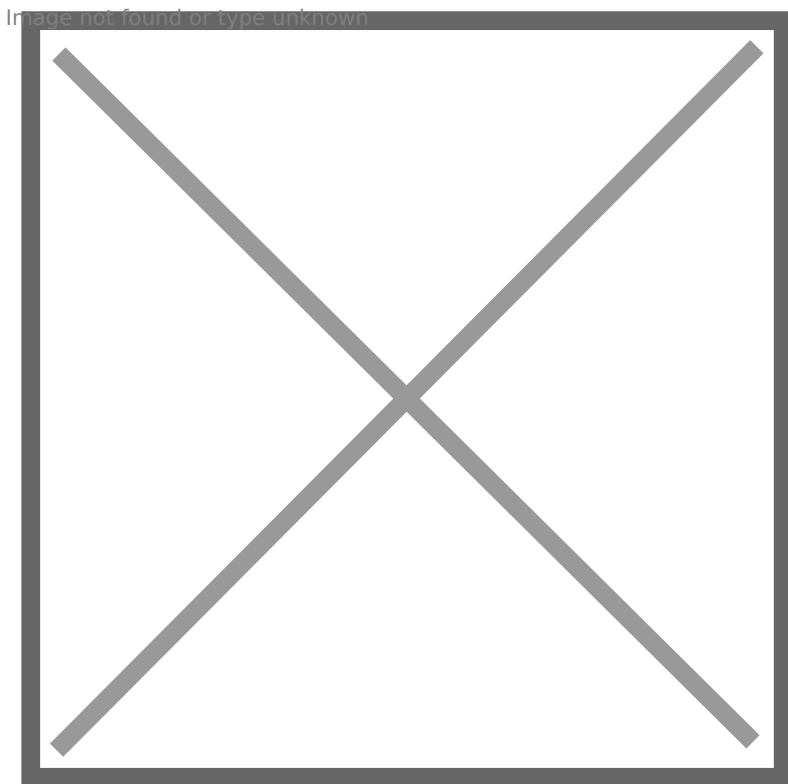

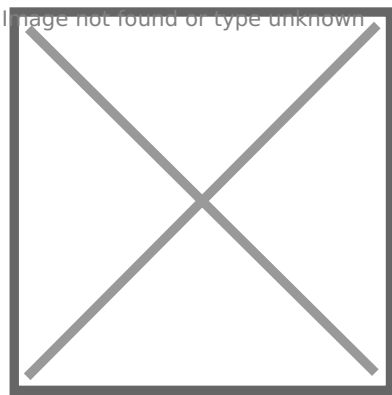
Over **1,400** Jewish pilgrims visited the Temple Mount on Monday, the second intermediate day of the **Sukkot** holiday...

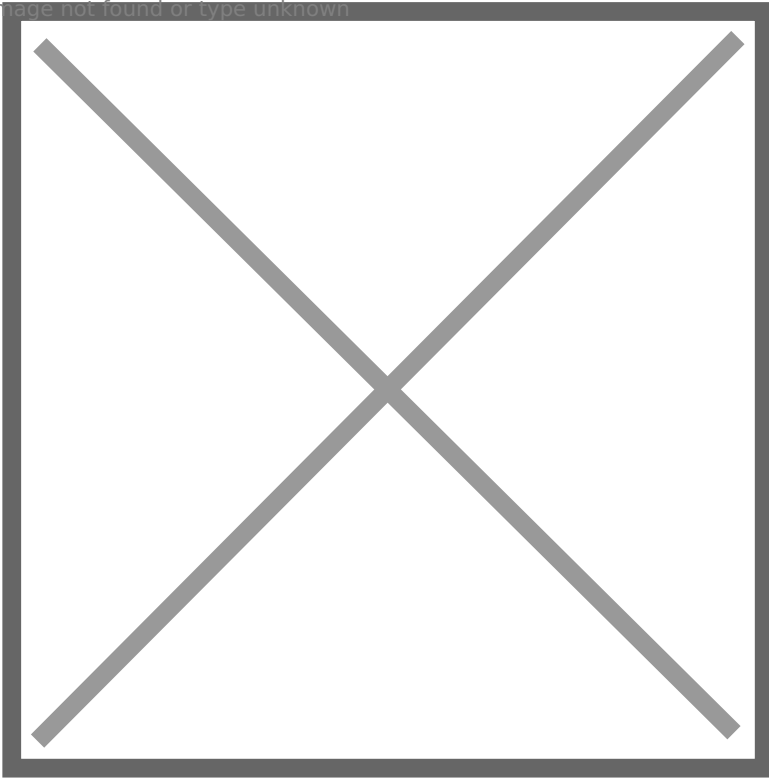

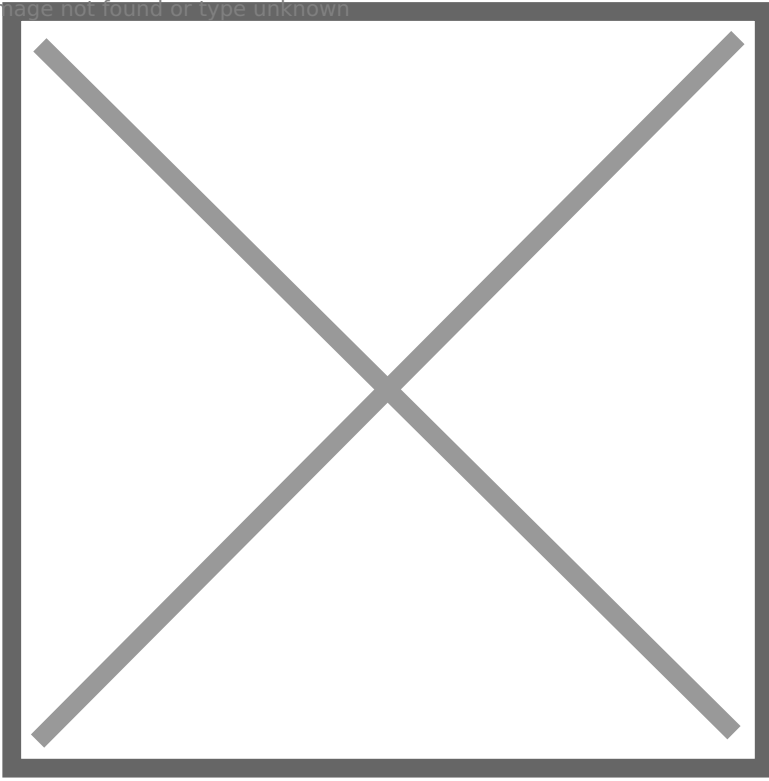
