"For **many will come in My name, saying, 'I am the Christ,'** and will deceive many.


"And you will hear of **wars and rumors of wars**. See that you are not troubled; for all these things must come to pass, but the end is not yet.

Messianic Claimants


Below is a timeline graph produced using data from Wikipedia article [List of people claimed to be Jesus](#). For purposes of plotting, `date-of-birth + 30 years` is used as the date for each individual, and quantity of individuals is summed inside 10 year intervals.



Wars




Famines
